



Processing plant by-product Mindoro Nickel to become major RP fertilizer producer

NICKEL processing plant by-products Intex Resources Phils., Inc. last week disclosed that the design of the processing plant for the Mindoro Nickel Project has been reconfigured that would allow it to produce fertilizer as a by-product and possibly help meet the Philippines' fertilizer requirements.

"The Project has been reconfigured to become not only the Philippines' largest and most modern nickel plant with a target production of 40,000 tons per annum of nickel metal but also its largest fertilizer plant with a production of as much as 200,000 tons a year of ammonium sulphate – a commonly used fertilizer.

In a real sense then, the Mindoro Nickel can substantially support Philippine agriculture by providing a reliable and local source for its most commonly used fertilizer," according to Atty. Leo Cleto Gamolo, president of Intex Resources Phils., Inc.

Even as the ammonium

sulphate fertilizer by-product can be a boon to Philippine agriculture, it can pave the way for significant foreign exchange savings in terms of fertilizer that will no longer have to be imported.

Based on latest data available from the National Statistics Office, the Philippines imported some US\$524.02 million worth of fertilizers for the period January-November 2008. Of this total, US\$182.1 million represented importations of urea fertilizer while the balance of US\$341.92 million were for non-urea fertilizers, which is the grouping that ammonium sulphates are categorized.

"As we move the project forward, we are beginning to realize unexpected but certainly most welcome developments. In addition to ammonium sulphate, the reconfigured Mindoro Nickel Project will be able to produce another by-product – cobalt compounds in the form of sulphates, carbonates, hydroxides and oxides," Gamolo said.

Among others, a consumer

application of cobalt compounds is their use in the production of rechargeable batteries for cellular phones – a consumer product that has been growing by leaps and bounds not only worldwide but particularly in the Philippines where about half the population has a cellphone.

In the field of agriculture, cobalt compounds can also be blended with fertilizer or can be used as a dietary supplement for livestock. "Even better is the fact that we will be mostly utilizing carbon-free energy in producing nickel and by-products such as fertilizer and cobalt compounds. The high-pressure acid leach (HPAL) technology for our nickel processing plant is such that we will be generating our own power in a most environmentally-friendly manner.

We will not be using fossil fuels nor will we be emitting carbon dioxide greenhouse gases," he pointed out. Gamolo said that the plant will not be dependent on

Mindoro's power grid for its requirements. "In fact, there is the possibility that we will be generating more power than we actually would need. Initially, we will be generating around 50 megawatts, which will subsequently increase to 80 megawatts.

The excess can be passed on Mindoro's power grid," he added. Mindoro Nickel is the flagship project of Intex Resources ASA of Norway, a dynamic emerging mining company focused on non-precious and mineral projects.

The Norwegian company is in the Philippines through its subsidiary Intex Resources Phils., Inc. Initial estimates of the capital cost for the project is estimated at around US\$2 billion. Intex's Philippine partners in the Mindoro Nickel Project are Aglubang Mining Corporation and Alagang Mining, Inc.

The nickel project is located in the island of Mindoro, straddling the mountain ranges of both Oriental Mindoro and Occidental Mindoro. A full feasibility study of the Mindoro Nickel Project is currently underway

with Aker Solutions of Australia and is expected to be completed in December 2009.

Earlier, a positive pre-feasibility study undertaken in 2007 indicated that the project has robust economics. Mindoro Nickel promises to be one of the world's major discoveries of nickel.

The project has become possible after the discovery of a large nickel deposit in Mindoro – estimated to hold over 200 million tonnes of nickel laterites.

The project is expected to bring a new and unexpected opportunity for economic and industrial development in Mindoro.

At present, Mindoro's economy is based on traditional farming and fishing, both of which are highly vulnerable to seasonal typhoons and floods which regularly cause massive destruction to crops and infrastructure.

Thai rider rules Puerto Princesa Asian Motocross

THAI ace rider Thanarat Penjan unveiled a ferocious show of force, pulling a big sweep to capture the crown in the 2009 Motocross Masters of Asia - Puerto Princesa International Motocross Grand Prix at the challenging Sta. Monica International Racetrack in Puerto Princesa City.

Living up to his tag, the 19-year-old Penjan was simply unstoppable aboard his Yamaha JAW Thai DID team bike as he controlled the tempo coast-to-coast to claim the coveted silver Mayor Edward S. Hagedorn Cup in this event sanctioned by National Motorcycle Sports and Safety Association (NAMSSA).

His feat brought the championship belt back to Thailand after Arnon Theplib won the crown two years back the said event which is part of the festivities for Puerto Princesa's 137th Foundation anniversary and the 5th Balayong Festival celebrated on March 4.

Even at the start, Thanarat showed he came for nothing but the crown as he topped the qualifying time trials with a time of 1:21.67.

And as soon as the green flag was hoisted, the Thai rider quickly pulled away fast from the rest of the 24-man pack to the delight of the 30,000 Puerto Princesa spectators.

First turn had a massive pile up with eight riders going down which included Aep Dadang Indonesian Champ and Iran National Champion Mojtaba.

That set the stage for Thanarat's dominance, winner of the Asian Supercross Championships in Jember Stadium, Indonesia last November 2008, as he gained distance after every lap to secure an unmolested lead at the halfway mark over veteran Japanese champion Shinichi Kaga, whom gave freestyle exhibition in the opening ceremonies and the Asian Motorcycle Sports Academy

Coach and reigning titlist Erdenbileg Khaliunbold. Kaga, parading his Suzuki, checked in second while Khaliunbold took third place honors with his Kawasaki.

Another Thai Honda entry Kriangkrai Thiannok made it fourth while Iran's Amirreza Sabetifar ended fifth.

RP's top bet Kenneth San Andres gave a good fight as he was consistently second in the first few laps of the race but the foreign challenge proved tough as he slipped down to sixth overall.

Completing the top 10 finishers were Indonesia's Yusuf Irawan and three Filipinos – Ted Conde, former 11-time champion Jolet Jao and young Cebuano ace Jon Eleazar Adlawan.

But the Philippines dominated International 12-14 year-old Juniors 85cc class via a 1-2-3 finish behind champion Jean Erick Mitra, Renato Mangosong and Patrick North Orbe, beating highly-favored Iranian young ace Hamedrel Adlelgo.

The said event will be beamed to over 600 million viewers worldwide through the ESPN and Star TV in two weeks time that they will be here to cover the largest ongoing motorsports event in Philippine history now on its 5th year.
